23rd and Walnut

Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three floats and top three decorated bicycles or walkers.

Floats - 1st = \$100.00, 2nd = \$75.00, 3rd = \$50.00

Bikes & Walkers will be awarded special prizes

All float walker and bike entries will be judged on how the entry carries through with the use of the parade theme, neatness and difficulty of entry.

If you have a float to be considered for cash prizes, please be in line no later than 9:45 a.m.

Judging will be conducted during line up

Winners will be announced at the end of the parade Street. Prizes will be available at the Goddard Community Center from Lions Club Staff following the parade.

The theme of the 2011 Fall Festival is Party in the Park. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three floats and special prizes will be awarded to three decorated bicycles or walkers.

Please follow these instruction for the PARADE CHECK IN!

- **MAIN STREET AND WALNUT ARE BOTH CLOSED TO TRAFFIC — Take Goddard Road to 23rd Street and turn right to Walnut. VERY LIMITED PARKING AVAILABLE — See instructions for walkers/riders below.**

- **All entries for the parade, except bands should come to CHECK IN north of the corner of 23rd & Walnut.**

- **A Parade Registration form will be available there if you don't have one filled out.**

- **Traffic will not be able to go south or enter Walnut from Third Street or from side streets due to parade lineup.**

- **Shriners meet north of Clark Davidson School at Ball Diamonds. Gary Rundell will coordinate.**

- **Car Entries are to meet behind Clark Davidson School.**

- **Marching Bands will form at Oak Street Elementary. Bands will flow into parade lineup at 4th and Oak.**

- **Bicycles/Walkers who are being judged for costumes will meet at the south end of Oak Street Elementary by 9:45 for judging. The bicyclists/walkers/kid entrants will flow into the parade at 3rd and Pine. All other walkers should go to Discovery School and walk over to Walnut and get in the parade on Walnut.**

- **Large groups of walkers or float riders should park and organize at the Goddard Ball Complex/ (behind the USD 265 Administration building on south Main Street). Proceed on foot to Richard Road & Walnut by walking through the ball diamonds or field west of the school building to Walnut. This should help with traffic problems at 23rd & Walnut. Do not come to check-in until your group is present and ready to be assigned your slot in the parade.**

- **Only one representative needs to come to registration. The completed registration sheets will be collected and a number assigned by a Lions Club member before the parade begins. The assigned number is used to identify your float or entry.**

- **Please display the number on the front of your entry towards the west/right so the announcer can see it. Please allow 30 yards between entries during parade.**

- **Parade ends at parking lot at the Discovery Intermediate School (at the USD 265 administration building). Parade participants can be picked up there. Please use south drive by the tennis courts to enter and leave parking lot.**

NOTICE

No candy or other items are to be thrown to the crowd from floats!

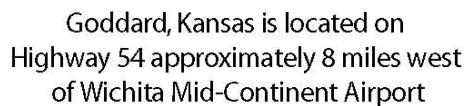
Candy or items can be handed out. Violators will be removed from parade by Goddard Lions or law enforcement. Crowds will be held back to the side of the street during the parade by volunteers.

**Decorated Walkers and Bike Riders
meet here at 9:45 for judging.**

Groups with large numbers of float riders and walkers should organize in the west parking lot of the USD 265 Administrative Center. Walkers then should proceed to Walnut Street by walking across the ball complex to Walnut. Have one person from the group check in with a Lion at 23rd and Richard Rd. The rest of the group get in line on Walnut Street. Parade numbers are not being given out until you reach 3rd and Oak Street. Make sure you have your parade registration form filled out before your group reaches 3rd and Oak.
